Terry was born in Winnipeg, MB and raised in Port Coquitlam, BC with brothers Fred and Darrell and sister Judith. At age 18 he was diagnosed with osteogenic sarcoma (a type of bone cancer) in his right leg, which led to the leg being amputated above the knee. For some people, losing a leg might seem like the end of everything. But for Terry, it was the start of everything.

During his 18 months of treatment, Terry met many people also facing cancer, including children. He wanted to do something to help so he decided to run across Canada to raise money for cancer research. He called his run the Marathon of Hope.

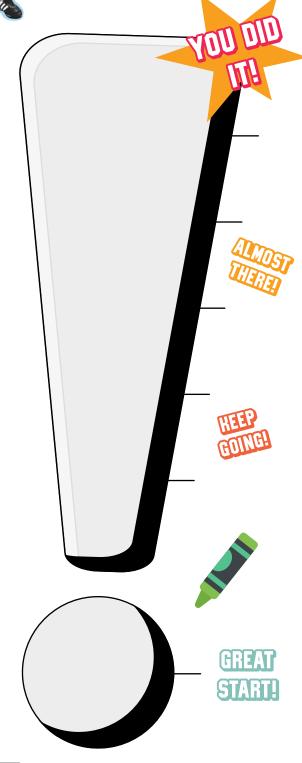
